This half term we will be sending your children home with the numbers to 5 and the letters s,a,t,p,i,n to be practised at home with your child. It is very important that you engage in home learning with your child.

Our theme for this half term will be "Winter Wonderland and Festivals"

Please find below the curriculum links for this half term.

Literacy

Reading and Reading Books In Nursery.

Children will read to an adult at least once a week and their reading books will be changed once each week. Please try and listen to your child read or share a book with them every night and write any comments in their reading journal!

Throughout the half term we will be looking at a variety of festivals including Diwali and using a range of Winter and Christmas themed books to support our learning. The children will be encouraged to take part in a range of mark making activities.

Maths

In maths the children will be learning to match numeral to quantity, order numbers correctly and recite number names in order.

The children will be learning about 2D shapes and using them to make pictures and arrangements.

For example the children will use shapes to create firework pictures.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be given the opportunity to engage in imaginative role play in the Gruffalo's Cut and Snip Salon that has arrived in the classroom.

The children will be encouraged to take part in a range of creative activities such as snow themed pictures, firework pictures, Rangoli patterns and playing with real snow!





Autumn Term 1 Curriculum Links

PSE

The children will continue to develop their social skills by making positive relationships with both adults and peers. We will continue to embed the 'good sitting rules' and encourage the children to use good manners in and around the academy.

Understanding of the World

The children will be given the opportunity to use the IWB within the classroom to support their mark making and design skills.

The children will be taking part in activities that encourage them to think about seasons as Autumn changes to Winter.

Physical Development

The children will be taking part in dance on a weekly basis and in PE the children will be learning key skills such as throwing and catching, kicking a ball and parachute games.

PE days are Tuesday and Thursday, children to come dressed in full PE kit!

Communication and Language

Throughout the half term the children will continue to be encouraged to use clear voices when talking in a group.

Staff will be modelling language related to the topic and encouraging the children to use this within their independent learning.
