Year 5 visit to Apedale Heritage Centre

Dear Parents,

This autumn term, the Year 5 pupils are studying the theme of 'Firedamp and Davy lamps' in history. As part of their studies, we are planning to visit Apedale Heritage Centre on Friday 8th October. This will be a great opportunity for the children to see the inner workings of a disused coal mine, as well as an informative mining museum and a walk around the countryside of Apedale to see old colliery buildings.

Children will need to arrive at the academy at the normal time and are required to wear full school uniform and sensible shoes. All children must bring a warm coat in case of bad weather. We will return before the end of the academy day.

We request that you supply your child with a packed lunch from home, unless they are in receipt of Free School Meals.

The cost of this subsidised visit is £10.00 per child to cover the cost of entry and transportation. Payment for the visit needs to be made online via School Money or by barcode NO LATER THAN 1st October 2021.
