As part of the recovery curriculum, the government are funding additional tutoring in school. Looking at the data, we believe that your child will benefit from the additional adult time.

Our Phonics and reading tutoring will start after half term. All staff taking part have completed additional tutoring training and therefore all children will get the same experience regardless of the adult who is tutoring them. The groups will contain no more than 3 children.

The tutoring sessions will be held on both Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8:10am - 8:40am. This will give them a full hour tuition each week. The children will be offered a slice of toast free of charge as we are aware that this will be an early start for them.

For children in years 1 to 5, the tutoring sessions will last for 15 weeks. The first session will be on Tuesday March 8th. The last session will be on Thursday 7th July. Please note that there will be no tutoring week beginning 9th May due to Y6 SATs.

For children in year 6, they will have tutoring sessions on Tuesday and Thursday morning 8:10 - 8:40am and an additional hour session on Tuesday after school 3:15 - 4:15pm. Their sessions will start on Tuesday 8th March and will be completed by Thursday 5th May in time for their SATs exams.

It is vitally important that if you accept the tuition place, that you commit to bringing your child to every session. If you do not think that this is a commitment that you can make, please inform us so that we can offer your child's place to a different child.
