Dear Parents/ Carers,

During the week beginning the **9th May**, the Year 6 children will be sitting their Year 6 end of year tests. (SATs). They have worked so very hard through some difficult years and these tests will allow them to show off their learning. This will be the first time in two years that the tests will have been taken and they provide valuable information to the secondary schools ready for transition. It is therefore vital that your child attends school every day and on time please. **From Monday to Thursday, we would like the children to start school at 8:15am. We will provide breakfast for them. They will also need their PE Kit on these days.**

There will be at least one test each day:

Monday 9 th May	Grammar, punctuation Spelling
Tuesday 10 th May	Reading
Wednesday 11 th May	Maths Paper 1 (arithmetic) Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning)
Thursday 12 th May	Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

On **Friday 13th May**, we will be walking the children to **Westport Lake** for a day of fun and a picnic. Your child will need to come out of uniform, bring a packed lunch (lunches will be provided for those children in receipt of Free School Meals) and some money for an ice-lolly.
