# Why Attendance Matters

#### Stay on Track

#### **Reduce Anxiety**


Your child will feel connected academically and socially when they have good attendance.

Good school attendance helps to build habits that will last a lifetime and transfer to life beyond public school

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#### A PENALTY NOTICE IS A TYPE OF FINANCIAL PENALTY YOU MUST PAY

From 19 August 2024 you will be issued a Penalty Notice if your child has a total of 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in any period of 10 weeks.

Penalty Notices are issued to each parent, for each child.

This means if Penalty Notices were issued for 3 siblings, they would be issued to both parents – 6 Penalty Notices in total.

Legal proceedings will be taken against you if payment of a Penalty Notice is not made within 28 days.

#### **First offence**

- First Penalty Notice per parent, per child, you must pay:
- £80 if you pay within 21 days
- £160 if you pay after 21 days but within 28 days

#### Second offence within 3 years

- Second Penalty Notice within 3 years per parent, per child, you must pay: • £160 within 28 days
- 2100 within 20 days


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#### Any other offence within 3 years

Legal proceedings will be taken against you if:


· your child has any further unauthorised absences within 3 years

#### Timeline

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#### Reporting Absence 🔓

Mrs Wedgwood is spending a considerable amount of time calling families that have not reported absence by 9am. This prevents Mrs Wedgwood from being able to do the tasks that she needs to do by certain times and from supporting the wider academy need. As part of our Home School Agreement and Admissions, parents and carers must call or send a Dojo message by 9am.

Uniform Reminder

All children are expected to be in the full, correct uniform every day. This includes plain black shoes and a school PE kit.

Please ensure that all uniform has your child's full name clearly labelled in it - the back of the badge is a good place to use for jumpers. We have numerous uniform that goes missing daily and we are unable to locate or find jumpers, cardigans etc if they are not clearly labelled with your child's name to identify it as theirs.

Children can wear a pair of stud earrings but any hoop earrings, rings, bracelets, necklaces and gel/stick on nails are not permitted for health and safety reasons as if these get caught outside on the equipment they pose a serious injury risk. Earring should be removed before school on swimming and PE days - if your child wears earrings on a PE or swimming day they will need to remove them by themselves and be responsible for looking after them. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings nor be accountable for looking after them






